In 2015 I spent three months on the remote British island of Pitcairn in the Pacific. Pitcairn is home to just 42 people, most of whom are descendants of the Bounty Mutiny. In 2004, the island's romantic image was ripped apart by a series of child abuse trials. Now just one child remains. An enigmatic place - legendary and infamous.

The Pitcairn Islands consist of four different islands, of which only the volcanic outcropping of Pitcairn is actually inhabited. While there is evidence of Polynesian tribes living on all four islands before the British, Pitcairn as we know it now is made up entirely of the descendants of British mutineers from the 1790s.
