

Who is developing Burkina Faso's solar power plants?

The solar plants are being developed by BioTherm Energy, a Power Africa partner. SONABEL, Burkina Faso's national electricity company, uses thermal (heavy fuel oil) and hydropower to cover an estimated 60% of the country's current electricity capacity. The rest is imported from Côte d'Ivoire and Ghana, as part of the West African Power Pool (WAPP).

How has Burkina Faso changed over the years?

Burkina Faso has made remarkable progress in recent years, with an increase in installed capacity from 324.6 megawatts (MW) in 2017 to 410 megawatts in 2019. The share of renewable energy also surged from 9.4% in 2015 to 18.36% in 2019.

Will Burkina Faso increase its electricity access rate by 2020?

By 2020, Burkina Faso seeks to increase its electricity access rate from 20% to 80% as part of its National Plan for Economic and Social Development, doubling the number of customers to 1 million, and increasing installed capacity to 1,000 megawatts (MW).

How long does a power outage last in Burkina Faso?

The average power outage time was 233 hours in 2018, compared with 172 hours in 2017. In addition, the cost of energy remains high for households and businesses, at XOF 75 per kWh of high-voltage electricity in 2019. No on-grid IPPs operating in Burkina Faso

What will Burkina Faso do in 2025?

By 2025, Burkina Faso seeks to lower its cost of energy, increase the access rate to 95%, increase installed capacity to 2,000 MW, and begin exporting oil and gas to nearby countries.
