

Where is the new solar energy plant located in Burkina Faso?

Located some 250km south east of the nation's capital city of Ouagadougou, near the town of Pâ, the new solar energy plant will supply all the electricity it produces to Burkina Faso's national power utility, La Société National D'électricité Du Burkina Faso (SONABEL).

Why does Burkina Faso need electricity?

The country has one of the world's lowest rates of electrification. Because of a shortage of installed energy generation capacity, Burkina Faso needs to import electricity from neighbouring states. Urbanisation, structural changes to the economy and recent strong GDP growth have increased demand for energy.

How much is a Burkina Faso electricity contract worth?

The contract is worth EUR1.5m. Although the Spanish company Tyspa and Morocco's Novec had also both had expressed their interest in the contract to Societe Nationale d'Electricite du Burkina Faso (Sonabel), they were eliminated from the bidding in early March after a technical evaluation of their submissions.

In a significant step towards enhancing electricity supply and sustainable development, Burkina Faso signs an agreement for a 50 MWp solar power plant in Komsilga. The initiative, led by the Minister of Energy and Energie Plus, aims to fortify renewable energy contributions, fostering economic growth and improved access to electricity.
