Solar panels cost anywhere from \$3,500 to \$55,000, including professional labor and materials. Most homeowners pay an average of \$27,173 on their solar panel installation costs. However, solar panel prices depend on factors like the type of panel, its wattage, and the number of panels purchased.

The final variable is how much electricity each solar panel can produce per peak sun hour. This is called power rating and it's measured in Watts. Solar panel power ratings range from 250W to 450W. How much do solar panels cost for a 2,000 square foot house? Based on national averages, solar panels cost just over \$20,000 for a house with 2,000 square feet of living space. The gross cost is closer to \$29,000, but claiming the federal solar tax credit worth 30% of the project cost brings the net cost down to around \$20,000.
