Renewable electricity is the share of electricity generated by renewable power plants in total electricity generated by all types of plants. Eswatini renewable energy for 2015 was 46.57%, a 6.69% decline from 2014.; Eswatini renewable energy for 2014 was 53.26%, a 12.6% increase from 2013.; Eswatini renewable energy for 2013 was 40.66%, a 3.13% decline from 2012.
