

What does Portugal stand for?

How old is Portugal?

Portugal's population has been steadily ageing and was the 11th oldest in the world, with a median age of 46 years in 2023. In the same year, it had the world's 4th highest number of citizens over 65 years, at 21.8% of the whole population. [ 213 ][ 214 ]

What are the tourist hotspots in Portugal?

Tourist hotspots in Portugal are: Lisbon, Cascais, Algarve, Madeira, Nazaré, Fátima, Évora, Porto, Braga, Guimarães and Coimbra. Lisbon attracts the sixteenth-most tourists among European cities [192] (with seven million tourists occupying the city's hotels in 2006). [193]

What is a local administrative unit in Portugal?

Operationally, the municipality and civil parish, along with the national government, are the only legally local administrative units identified by the government of Portugal (for example, cities, towns or villages have no standing in law, although they may be used as catchment for the defining services).

Who is responsible for drug decriminalisation in Portugal?

The Public Ministry, headed by the Attorney General of the Republic, constitutes the independent body of public prosecutors. Drug decriminalisation was declared in 2001, making Portugal the first country to allow usage and personal possession of all common drugs.

Does Portugal have a relationship with the United Kingdom?

It has a friendship alliance and dual citizenship treaty with its former colony, Brazil. Portugal and the United Kingdom share the world's oldest active military accord through their Anglo-Portuguese Alliance (Treaty of Windsor), signed in 1373.
