

How much energy can Grenada generate?

According to estimates from the United States' National Renewable Energy Laboratory, Grenada could eventually generate up to 20 MW from wind, 25 to 50 MW from solar, and more than 50 MW from geothermal energy.

Who is responsible for energy projects in Grenada?

The MOID (Ministry of Infrastructure Development, Public Utilities, Energy, Transport, and Implementation) is responsible for energy programs in Grenada. MOID handles the majority of permitting related to energy projects.

Where do companies find oil & gas in Grenada?

Companies began to search for offshore oil and gas in Grenada's waters in 2017 following the passage of a Hydrocarbon Exploration Incentive Bill. The area of focus is where the maritime boundaries of Grenada and Trinidad and Tobago meet. During a 2018 exploration by Global Petroleum Group, indications of natural gas were found.

Does Grenada have a national oil company?

Grenada does not have a national oil company. The Global Petroleum Group and an undisclosed Chinese company were heading oil exploration projects in Grenada as of October 2018. As of early 2021, approximately 235 employees worked for Grenlec on electrical generation, transmission, and distribution.

How does MOID work in Grenada?

MOID handles the majority of permitting related to energy projects. Electricity self generators must apply for a permit through the PURC (Public Utilities Regulatory Commission), Grenada's regulatory authority for energy.

Is biomass a source of electricity in Grenada?

Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included. This can be an important source in lower-income settings. Grenada: How much of the country's electricity comes from nuclear power? Nuclear power - alongside renewables - is a low-carbon source of electricity.
