

Walkable solar panels South Georgia and South Sandwich Islands

What are walkable solar panels?

Walkable solar panels come in several types and specifications. They can be bendable, also called semi-flexible, which means it will not break or crack when you walk over it. High-quality glass-on-glass solar panels are also available as walkable PV panels. The panel consists of several layers of glass with layers of film between the glass.

What types of solar cells are available for walk-on solar panels?
